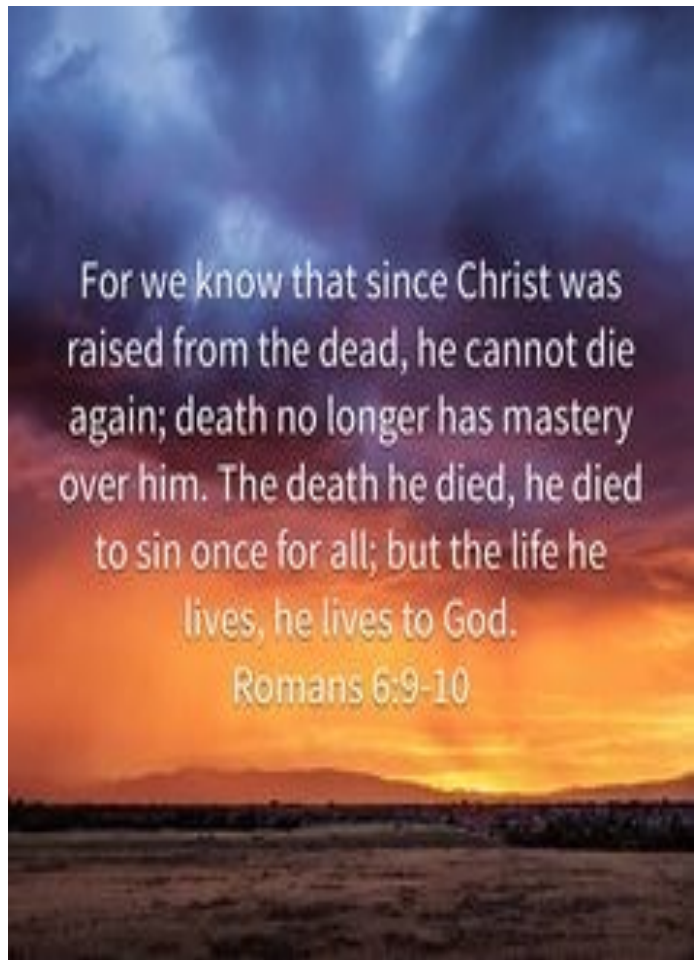

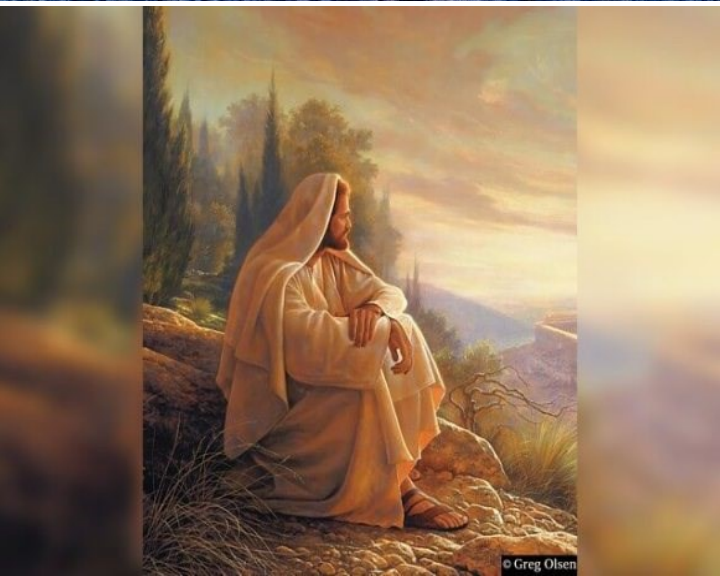
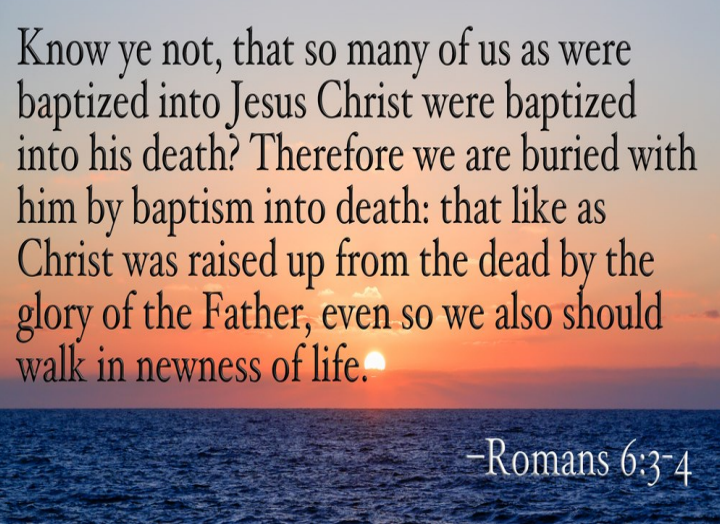
NEW PARISHIONERS: Please register by completing a yellow registration form located at the back of the church and place in the collection basket.
