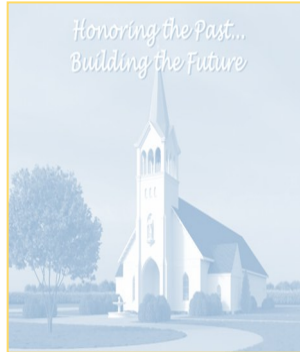

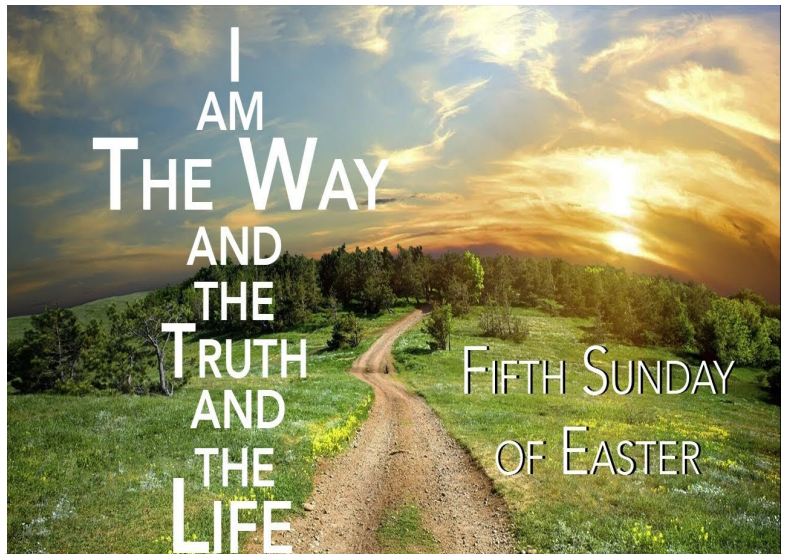
May 6th Remember Mothers Day
